Appropriation (National Parliament 2014) Bill 2013

Being an Act to appropriate out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund a sum for the National Parliament for Operational Expenditure for the year ending 31 December 2014.

MADE by the National Parliament.

1. GRANT OF K130,724,600.

Subject to authorization from the Minister, the Secretary for Treasury may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund and apply for the operational expenditure of the National Parliament for the year ending 31 December 2014 the sum of K130,724,600.

2. APPROPRIATION.

Sums granted by this Act out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the financial year ending 31 December 2014 are appropriated for the operational expenditure of the agency listed in the Schedule of this Act.
